#### **Enjoying God's Gift of Money**

"God...richly provides us with everything to enjoy" (1 Timothy 6:17). Of all the wonderful gifts that God gives us, the one we struggle with the most is money. In order to enjoy money, we need to control it rather than letting it control us. Controlling our money requires spending some time and effort in planning how we are going to save, spend, and give it. If we fail to control and plan how we are going to manage our money, our financial lives will be filled with disappointment, frustration, and chaos, rather than the enjoyment of the money God enables us to earn (Deuteronomy 8:18).

God's Word gives us wisdom on the importance of saving, spending, and giving money so money can be a blessing that we can enjoy.

<u>Saving</u>: It is not easy to save money because our sinful nature is always craving for more and more possessions, as luxuries become, in our minds, necessities. The Bible tells us that saving for the future and investing what we save is a wise thing to do. In Proverbs 21:20 we read, "Precious treasure and oil are in a wise man's dwelling, but a foolish man devours it." We are also told to observe the ant who gathers food for the winter (Proverbs 6:6-8). Saving money will help us make better decisions and ensure that we will have money to pay for things we need without incurring interest charges. Saving will enable us to enjoy our money because we won't always be in a financial crisis.

<u>Spending:</u> Televangelist John Hagee wrote, "Since my money is God's money, every spending decision I make is a spiritual decision." In Matthew's Gospel, we are warned, "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy..." (Matthew 6:19). Only by controlling our spending on luxuries for ourselves will we be able to save and to give in ways that lay up treasures in Heaven. In order to use wisely and enjoy the money God gives us, we need to have a spending plan.

<u>Giving</u>: By God's grace, we will live wisely in order to give generously. Jesus said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35). Through the work of the Holy Spirit, we will be able and willing to give money through our church on the first day of every week according to the blessings that we receive from Him (1 Corinthians 16:2). As Rev. Stephen Olford, a 20<sup>th</sup> century Christian leader, aptly stated, "Giving satisfies the soul, edifies the church, and magnifies the Lord." God's Word exhorts us to give cheerfully and generously (2 Corinthians 9:7). In giving, we emulate God's nature of giving, which enables us to experience the joy of giving.

#### **Stewardship Corner**

God's Word tells us that we are saved by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8). Through the work of the Holy Spirit, we understand that our works and deeds play no part in our justification. But unless faith produces works of love and obedience it is dead (James 2:14-17). In the words of Martin Luther, "There is a beautiful agreement between faith and good works; nevertheless, it is faith alone which apprehends the blessing without works, and yet faith is at no time alone."

#### **Stewardship Corner**

A steward is one to whom certain property is entrusted to be managed according to the will or direction of the owner. A faithful steward does not hide or bury the resources or fail to be trustworthy in conducting the master's business as was the case with the third servant in the Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14-30). We have the responsibility to use the gifts given to us in a loving, gracious manner as we faithfully carry out our master's will. Because of our faithfulness, we will hear the words, "Well done, good and faithful servant" (verse 21).

#### **Stewardship Corner**

In 1 Peter 4:10, we read that the Holy Spirit gives each of us different gifts that are to be used in service to others. "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace" (1 Peter 4:10). God wants each of us to be more than spectators. It is God's will that we understand and fulfill the tasks that He gives to each of us. With the gifts that God has entrusted to us, we function together as God's people and make the Body of Christ function for His glory. The good of all is enhanced when we make our contribution.

#### **Stewardship Corner**

In the Parable of the Dishonest Manager (Luke 16:1-13), the master fired his steward or manager, because he was not doing a good job. The steward was not being responsible or was mismanaging his master's money so he was discharged from his duties. This leads to the question for us: Are we faithfully managing God's possessions? Are we demonstrating our faithfulness by living for and serving God? Jesus ends this parable with the words "No servant can serve two masters..." For most of us the ultimate question is "Are we living for worldly things or are we serving God?"


